

Downloading an eBook

You CANNOT download directly to an iPad, iPhone or Kindle or other tablet. You MUST download to a computer first and then transfer by Wi-Fi or cable to these devices.

eBooks come in two formats. Be careful and select the version you need.

1. ePub for reading on Windows or Mac computers, iPad, iPhone or tablets
2. Mobi which is ONLY for reading on a KINDLE tablet.

For reading on your Windows or Mac computer, iPad, iPhone or a tablet select the **top "BUY NOW" Button**. This is the ePub version.

Kindle Readers ONLY. You should you select the **bottom BUY NOW** button. This is the Mobi version for Kindle Readers only. Kindle (Amazon) will not allow you to download our books to their Kindle Reader. You must download to a computer and then sync to your Kindle by WiFi or cable.

HOW IT WORKS

The eBook is stored by a firm called Pulley.

Once you pay through PayPal, Pulley will email you a download link. Click on that link & download to your computer.

If you've attempt to download the file more than three times Pulley cuts you off, declaring you've reached your download limit.

READING AN EBOOK ON YOUR COMPUTER

To read an eBook you need to have an eBook reader installed on your computer. **Adobe Reader is NOT an eBook Reader.**

Adobe Digital Editions is an excellent eBook reader and will read the ePub file you have downloaded.

It comes in two versions; one for Mac computer and one for Windows computers.

Download the free Adobe Digital Editions eBook reader installer from:

Locate your preferred platform and click on it to download the installer. Then run the installer on your machine to install Adobe Digital Editions.

Make sure you download the right version – either:

1. Download Digital Edition 4.0.3 Macintosh (19.2MB) OR
2. Download Digital Edition 4.0.3 Windows (7.7MB)

If you don't like Adobe Digital Editions there are many other eBook Readers on the internet, some free, some not.
